It will reflect on how we envisage the church’s ministry of healing in our contemporary world, with examples taken from the new book. It will also include an opportunity to sing some of the hymns!


Jan is Principal of Open College at Luther King House in Manchester, and programme leader for the MA. She teaches in the areas of pastoral and practical theology, and her research interests are in feminist liturgy and spirituality. She is a minister of the United Reformed Church. She is the author of *Ritual Making Women* (based on her doctoral research) and has produced her own collection of prayers, poems and hymns, *Naming God*, as well as publishing material for worship in various anthologies.

From 2009—2012 Jan worked part-time at Holy Rood House as Director of The Centre for the Study of Theology and Health, and lived as a residential community member for half the week. During that time Jan set up the Hymns for Healing project, and Holy Rood House thanks Jan for her inspiration and dedication to see this project through.

Saturday Workshop: The workshop will explore what the theme of healing means for us today, and will include opportunities to express this in words and music, liturgy and art. The Workshop will be followed by the Holy Rood House launch of the new book, published by Stainer and Bell edited by Jan Berry & Andrew Pratt:
