‘The Trauma of Domestic Violence’

Jeannette Roddy is a registered and accredited counsellor with BACP and has spent the last 10 years conducting research into working with people who have experienced mental health difficulties after domestic violence. She has taken her research from theory to practice, developing a model of practice and a competency framework for counselling practitioners. This practice model is currently being used in the Counselling Centre at the University of Salford where Jeannette is a Senior Lecturer and clinical lead for the Domestic Violence Counselling Service. The DV Counselling Service sees around 50 clients per week from Greater Manchester and across the UK.

Jeannette has presented her work at conferences in the UK and Europe, and is the author of the book "Counselling and Psychotherapy after Domestic Violence: a client view of what helps recovery". Uniquely, Jeannette's research includes both male and female survivors of domestic violence.

This workshop will look at the emotional and mental health consequences of domestic abuse, how this presents difficulties for individuals in asking for and accepting help and support and what can help. The workshop will include discussion and practice sessions as well as taught material and is suitable for anyone likely to work with survivors of domestic abuse, including counsellors, psychotherapists, social workers, clergy, medical staff and teachers.



Please note that this workshop presents a gender neutral view of domestic violence.
